Duration

Examination and Evaluation

The evaluation consists of internal test (5 marks), assignment (5 marks) and practicum (5 Marks) for 15 marks and a terminal examination for 35 marks.

The students who successfully complete the self-study courses shall be issued certificates by Nirmala memorial Foundation College of Education, Kandivali East, Mumbai.

- Self-study courses are obligatory for the completion of the B.Ed. Programme.

Facilities in the Library

NMFCE has an experienced librarian and one library attendant who look after the overall functioning of library such as its arrangement and display of books, acquisition cataloging, collection, dissemination, maintenance of website and other e-resources and provision of services to the users of library. All the reference books, journals, study materials and magazines are available to make students self study and learning easier.

Computer Lab Facilities

- In general, computing and internet facilities are available to all teachers and students on the campus.
- The institution provides access to desktop systems and laptops to both faculty and students which allows them to use computer aid for academic projects, practical sessions and for learning.
- To make the learning process more effective various innovative methods are used by the teachers. This includes giving group assignments and having power point presentations, where students can discuss and explore their knowledge together. Learning combined with visual presentations or working on certain software is much more enjoyable and comprehensive for the students.
- The e- resources with reference to all the self study courses is provided to students by using computer lab facilities. In PCs of computer laboratories, these e-resources were downloaded.
