Agenda wise points were discussed as below:

1. Review of the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 21/06/25 were read, reviewed and confirmed. The action taken report was discussed, highlighting the progress made on the action items identified in the previous meeting.

2. Quality enhancement program

The IQAC members discussed the importance of quality enhancement program for faculty and students to enrich and explore them with better experience. For this committee have proposed to organise seminar, workshops, guest lectures, celebrations of cultural festivals, days of importance, cultural programs, campus interviews, educational visit, annual picnic, etc. Such activities will help to boost institutional excellence.

A brief overview of the quality initiatives taken up by the IQAC was presented by Ms. Sweety Singh. These included

- Celebration of important days
- Three days inspire workshop under Heartfulness education program.
- Celebration of cultural festivals
- International conference in collaboration with other teacher education colleges.
- Expert talk on 'Overcoming procrastination'
- Expert talk on 'Importance of values in present education system'
- Talent hunt

3. PO's and CO's for each semester

PO's and CO's were discussed and approved in the meeting. Teacher representatives agreed to implement the discussed and approved PO's and CO's in lessons.

4. Value based reflective assembly

It was decided to have Value based reflective assembly where students can show motivational videos, conduct role plays, explain thought of the day, activities on team work, news reading, etc. followed by reflection. Students should be motivated and

5. Audit course

Teacher representative Ms. Shubhangi Kore introduced the audit course: Heartfulness Education Program, focusing on yoga, meditation and well-being.

It is planned to organise workshops and seminars so as to help student teachers to achieve the objectives of revised two years B.Ed. course syllabus. The audit course starts in semester 1 and is continued throughout all four semesters and will be certified at the end of semester 4, as a part of B.Ed. programme.

The most highlighted feature is the introduction of Audit course- Understanding the self. This course helps the student teacher to understand their role in shaping the young minds and positively channelize their untapped energy to develop one's own personality.

6. Activities under WDC

Workshop or seminar or debate would be organised to promote women's empowerment. Ms. Shubhangi Kore suggested organising Expert talk on POCSO Act 2012, Domestic Violence Act 2005 and Prenatal Diagnostic Technique Act 1994. Members appreciated her ideas and gave a few suggestions for effective organising and smooth implementation of the plan. Members suggested to invite Adv. Nalanda Badekar and Adv. Meetanshu Purandare for expert talk.

7. International conference

On 8th October 2025, MES's Pillai college of education and research with Nirmala Memorial Foundation College of Education and Oriental college of education and research will jointly organise an international conference on 'Empowering 21st Century Learners with Future Ready Skills'. Dr. Rupali Wadkar from NMFCE, Dr. Vinayak Shinde from OCER and Dr. Vithoba Sawant from PCER would be a part of organising committee. 
